#### Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2021-2022 school year.

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

In October parents of children in the school will receive a letter inviting them to apply for places for the incoming Junior Infant Classes. The notice will also be posted in the Clonburris Parish newsletter in October. Applications will be acknowledged when application forms are completed.

Only children who are four before the 30th June will be considered for Junior Infants.
