


Getting ready to go to the Test Centre.




There is a new type of flu called the coronavirus. It's kind of like a cold.

The Test Centre is in North Strand Health Centre. This is where the nurse is checking everyone.




My Mam or Dad will bring me there and stay with me the whole time.

The nice nurse will wave hello and bring us in to the room. She looks funny too.




She is wearing a big white sheet! We are all wearing these funny things to keep us safe.




First my Mam or Dad will talk to the nurse.
